SAMHE monitors are web-enabled and automatically transmit air quality data to our database. Please be assured, the monitor does not collect any personal data. The air quality data it collects will only be accessible to you, researchers involved with the SAMHE project, and other researchers as authorised by the project team. No other schools will be able to see the data from your monitor.
